## **EdelGive Foundation**

EdelGive Foundation was set up in 2008, as the philanthropic arm of the Edelweiss Group, to contribute to building sustainable institutions and organizations that promote societal growth and innovation, and advances the common good by bringing the skills, resources and talents of the for-profit world to the not-for-profit world. EdelGive aims to achieve 10X impact by providing NGOs with a combination of resources viz. direct funding, capacity building, and by linking NGOs to other funding sources, both public and private.

EdelGive works in the areas of **Education** by supporting government systems through teacher training and skill development to deliver quality education; **Women's empowerment** by focusing on social and/or economic empowerment programs including socio-legal support, Self Help Groups (SHGs), financial literacy etc.; and **Livelihoods** by providing relevant training, linking Self Help Groups (SHGs) to banking and loan facilities, and watershed management for NGO target communities.

In the last decade, EdelGive Foundation has influenced over Rs. 100 crores in philanthropy, impacted over 4.5 lakh lives and supported (financial and non-financial) over 130 organisations, in 14 states in India. Through its employee engagement program, EdelGive has provided over 29,000 hours in pro bono support from Edelweiss employees, with over 75% of them engaging in volunteering activities.
