Vrutti, founded in 2002, envisions to build wealth and resilience amongst small producers and vulnerable communities through transformative agrarian and allied livelihood solutions. The '3-fold model' of the organisation, is a flagship programme, which aims to make small land-holder farmers wealthy, resilient and responsible by enhancing their income upto 3 times.

- Direct engagement with 1,27,798 farmers through FPOs across 6 states
- Increase in average household net income by 74%

Action Related to Organisation of Education, Health and Nutrition (AROEHAN)

AROEHAN aims to bring about sustainable change in tribal communities in the Jawhar-Mokhada blocks of the Palghar district of Maharashtra. It incorporated an integrated approach to community development for better agricultural productivity, clean water availability, and better access to health, education, and electricity.

- 5,696 farmers planted 4,19,196 saplings of cashew, mango, sapota, lemon, and guava
- 8,120 Antenatal Care (ANC) procedures were conducted with 84 critical cases detected and referred for further advisement
- 12 villages have passed resolutions against child marriage owing to AROEHAN's extensive awareness initiatives





EdelGive was one of the first donors, who encouraged AROEHAN to embark on a multi-pronged intervention. The Foundation supported them in their early stages of staff development and in a host of other ways to assist them in emerging as a stable, professional and ethical organisation.

Action for Food Production (AFPRO)

AFPRO was incepted in 1967 to promote socio-technical development support to other grassroots level NGOs. Their operational strategy includes enabling vulnerable sections in society to become self-reliant through training, knowledge and technology transfer. AFPRO's focus areas include water, sanitation, hygiene, watershed development, food security and sustainable livelihoods.

- Over 20,000 different types of rain water harvesting structures created
- Outreach to over 2,00,000 villages

Basic HealthCare Services (BHS)

Basic HealthCare Services (BHS) was established in 2012 with a focus to provide high-quality, low-cost primary healthcare services for vulnerable communities in Rajasthan. They run Amrit Clinics in tribal and underserved areas providing preventive and promotive healthcare services and run a Primary Health Centre (PHC) in partnership with the Rajasthan Government.

- Footfall of over 1,76,000 patients at the Amrit Clinics and PHC with more than 50% women accessing the healthcare system
- Over 6,000 pregnant women received healthcare services, with over 1,700 institutional deliveries conducted

Gyan Prakash Foundation (GPF)

Founded in 2011, GPF was established as a public charitable trust, to join the efforts of various NGOs, corporates and the government, towards ensuring last mile connectivity for transformation in learning processes in zila parishad schools in Maharashtra. GPF works with the government system rather than creating parallel structures. GPF's work in the area of using child wise learning level data for classroom planning has contributed towards creation of the Competency based report card for classroom planning in collaboration with MSCERT, which was rolled out in the state of Maharashtra.









The Collaborators for Transforming Education, is a Public-Private Partnership model between EdelGive Foundation and the Government of Maharashtra, to support the Quality Education Programme (QEP) of the state. GPF is one of the implementing partners of the programme working across the districts of Parbhani and Nandurbar. Through this programme, GPF has been able to reach more than 11,00,000 children and support over 10,000 teachers in improving classroom processes. They have also supported over 200 government officials in executing QEP in the state.

Vacha emerged from the women's movement in 1990, and even today has an all women team working with marginalised girls and boys in their teens, with a special focus on adolescent girls. Vacha works with adolescent girls through the non-formal participatory methodology of learning and teaching. It focuses on bringing the voices and issues or aspirations of their girls, to the notice of relevant stakeholders through publications, films, photo exhibitions, and a range of advocacy material.
