MUMBAI: Private sector lender IndusInd Bank NSE 0.32 % on Thursday said it has committed Rs 30 crore towards Covid-19 relief efforts. The bank did not specify if it is contributing to any corpus like the PM CARES Fund and limited itself to saying that it is working with both the central and state governments to fight the pandemic.
